

Team Assistant: Team assistants are responsible for assisting the Team Leader and offering support to the group buddies and children within each group. The assistant is expected to stay with his/her group during the day and participate in activities. The assistant will be expected to aid the Team Leader in group activities.

Group Buddy: Each group will be assigned 2-3 group buddies to assist the Team Leader and the Team Assistant. The group buddies are expected to stay with his/her group during the day and participate in all activities. Buddies will also assist with the supervision of campers during breaks and activities.

Activity Assistants: Activity assistants are needed to aid each Activity Counselor in camp activities. They are: Visual journaling, horseback riding, archery, games and memorial services. The assistants are also expected to help set-up and clean up their particular activity.

Floater: Floaters are needed to assist behind the scenes at camp and duties include: Camp set-up, registration, serve breakfast/lunch and clean up/take down.

Security Team: Serves as contact as campers and volunteers arrive by directing designated parking, patrols facility during camp to maintain a safe environment, assists with any equipment issues as needed, facilitates orderly dismissal process to assure campers hand-off, and helps with pack up and load/unload after the conclusion of camp.

Clean-up Team: Arrive on Sunday afternoon, the day after camp, to clean site, check for and gather trash and dispose of properly, put up tables and chairs in appropriate place. Clean-up team will make sure that the facility is in the same condition as when camp started.
